In our churches, we've prayed for peace there most weeks — although our efforts hardly compare with the urgency of the prayers of Christians in Ukraine for those two years. And yet, the war grinds on. Does that mean that our prayers have not been heard? Or — worse — that prayer is not valid?

It's easy to let the mind wander down those avenues... but a little historical context helps. Jesus' death and resurrection at the first Easter ocurred in a world dominated by the Roman empire: the grotesque excesses of some of their emperors shows us that there is nothing new about a leader like Putin. Despite this oppressive regime and its persecutions, Christianity grew – and eventually even became the official religion of the Roman Empire.

We may not understand why God doesn't answer our prayers in the way that we think is right; but we need to recognise that God's plans stretch across far longer timescales and are more far-reaching than the limits of a human lifetime. The important thing for those of us who follow Jesus is to keep trusting in the truth of the gospel, irrespective of whether God answers our prayers how and when we want him to.
