one spouse reduces or removes the chance of much romance. It can be quite moving to witness the devotion of a loving, healthy spouse caring for his or her sick partner, whose infirmity has left romance far behind.

Jesus showed a deeper love still – in his life of healing the sick and teaching about the Kingdom of God, and ultimately in his death on the cross. The power of God's love was revealed when he raised Jesus from the dead. 
