Hi folks,

It's that time of year again: mince pies, baubles, tinsel, 'Jingle Bells' and Slade's 'Merry Christmas Everybody'. Part of me enjoys the fun and festivity; part of me - and I'm not sure whether I should admit this as a vicar! - thinks "ugh!". I certainly think, "None of this before Dec 1!"

All of this is a distraction from the central reality of Christmas: that God became a human being in Jesus.

Sometimes we can be a bit too familiar with the story to realise just how astonishing this belief about Jesus actually is: that the creator of the universe, who set up and set off the Big Bang, who thereby created the galaxies, the stars and the planets, who created life itself – then chose to become a human being, living, dying and rising again among us humans on Earth.

Why? Because God wanted us to know the depth of his love for us. The life of Jesus is the fullest expression of God's character that we have: if we want to know who God is, we need to know Jesus.

So while I hope we each enjoy the Christmas festivities in different ways, the most important aspect of it all is not about tinsel or 'Jingle Bells', but about what happened in a manger two thousand years ago, when God arrived in human form.


