Hi folks,

This set me thinking... how often

do we let things obscure our view of God's Son? Sometimes it may be genuine theological issues: why does God allow suffering, for example? (as with the hurricanes last month). Or it may be our own experiences which, for one reason or another, have led us to a negative impression of who God is. I don't for a moment want to underplay that.

However, sometimes it's more minor stuff: maybe we allow the busyness of our own lives to obstruct our view. Even church stuff can get in the way: we're so busy that we don't allow time for the most important thing, which is to develop our relationship with God. And yes, even vicars can be in danger of letting church stuff get in the way! ©

But if, as I believe, the good news of God's Son is the most important reality that we should be engaging with, then – where we easily can – we should make time to get a clearer view of him.
