#### Hi folks,

I've been fascinated by the gaggle of herons and egrets just to the south of Burtle Road over the last couple of days. Grey herons normally keep solitary – but not this time (see photo!). There were twenty or so cattle egrets (very rare here only a few years ago), similar numbers of little egrets (very rare twenty years ago) and even a glossy ibis (still a rarity, despite one being resident at Ham Wall for a couple of years).



What struck me most though was the opportunistic nature of these birds. They clearly felt that the digger was providing them with rich pickings from the peat that was being dredged up – even more so than the nearby fields which they've also been probing.

This set me thinking – are we

opportunistic enough in our relationship with God?

We often think of religion as prizing regularity and order – and as the vicar I'm not about to contradict that! But what if God doesn't act in a regular and orderly way? What if instead he shows up in irregular and unplanned ways?

One of my biggest sources of inspiration on my spiritual journey has been the Pentecostal movement, which is much more open to God's unexpected action – but even there there's a tendency to systematise what God does. Perhaps that's our human fallibility trying to control the uncontrollable?

Keen birders keep each other posted as to the latest notable sightings (eg "Western Cattle Egret, Westhay, 15:40, c.20 south of Burtle Road at ST422421;

also Glossy Ibis"); what if instead Christians were used to God-incidences in the same way? ("Healing of lame person, Westhay, 15:40, in field south of Burtle Road at ST422421").
