Its purpose is to provide a better, and more easily understandable, way of identifying your location than you can with postcodes or Grid References. To do this, the country has been divided into boxes 3m by 3m, and each box has been assigned three random words. Thus, the front door of the Vicarage is in regretted.helpful.extend, while the kitchen is in lung.shimmered.giraffes.

The Mongolian postal system and the Lonely Planet travel guides are two of the clients who have adopted the system. It has also proven useful for the emergency services in locating people much more quickly than before.

If we need to know where we are geographically, we also need to know where we are spiritually as well – both now and in the future. We can find ourselves asking questions like, "What significance is my life?"; "Where, if anywhere, am I headed after I die?"; "Is there more to life than this?".

This is why we're putting on the **Alpha** course, which is a series of sessions exploring the Christian faith, run over eleven weeks. Each talk looks at a different question around faith and is designed to stimulate conversation. Although it started in the UK, Alpha now takes place all around the globe, and everyone is welcome to come to it. There are three key things: food (there is a full meal each evening), a talk (a very well-produced video) and good



conversation. There's no obligation to say anything in the discussions and there's nothing you can't say (seriously). It's an opportunity to hear from others and contribute your own perspective in an honest, friendly and open environment.
