My faith in Jesus gives me a deeper sense of joy in the good times, a greater resilience in the difficult times – and a greater sense of the inherent goodness of our creator God.

That's why we run courses like Alpha – not for people to sign up to an ideology, but to share in the experience of a relationship with Jesus.
