I thought I'd start by sharing a photo that I took in March.

Great crested grebes have an elaborate courtship ritual which is very eye-catching, which I hadn't previously succeeded in photographing well. By chance I arrived at Ham Wall one morning recently just as a pair were about to start. It was amazing to see them rising up, penguin-like, feet

pattering quickly on the water surface, chest to chest, head-shaking with weed in their beaks. The weed appears to represent their saying, "Let's make a nest together!", as they will use this kind of material on their nests.

The climax of the Christian year, Easter, is on April 21. Despite the prevalence of eggs and bunnies, Easter lacks the commercialism that bedevils Christmas, so there's more chance for us to focus on what it's about.

On the first Good Friday, the Messiah and son of God, Jesus, was crucified. There's a lot of theological significance to this: in the old system, we made sacrifices to God to atone for our sinfulness; but now, Jesus became the sacrifice, so we don't have to. That's good news in itself: but far better is that death wasn't the end – Jesus rose again to show that, through God, death itself is defeated. We too can share the hope of eternal life with him if we accept that his death on the cross accounts for our sinfulness as well. Not a bad deal for us, all told!

Do come and celebrate with us on Easter Sunday – and maybe even consider coming to the sunrise service at Ham Wall!
