The resignation of Justin Welby as Archbishop of Canterbury was a sad way for him to go, but absolutely necessary considering his failure to act over the John Smyth case, given the appalling abuse that was involved. He had previously served the Church of England with considerable commitment, passion and deep faith, at a time when the denomination has become more deeply divided than ever. My hope and prayer for the Church of England is that the process to appoint his successor will not be deeply divisive - despite there being considerable potential for this.

In the final part of his resignation letter, he said:

...[A]bove all else, my deepest commitment is to the person of Jesus Christ, my saviour and my God; the bearer of the sins and burdens of the world, and the hope of every person.

That hope began two thousand years ago, when Jesus was born in Bethlehem. This is what we will be celebrating later this month at Christmas. Let us not become lulled by the traditions – but realise afresh how extraordinary it is that God himself became a human baby.

In a world where human power is expressed in walls and wars, God's power was revealed in an utterly different way.
