
Hi folks,

Last January, we ran the course **Invitation to Explore** for the first time. I had been a bit anxious beforehand about whether it would work: but we had ten guests to our first session, and similar numbers for the other two. We're therefore running it again: and because of how well it worked last time, I'm confident that it will be an enjoyable experience for all our guests this time!

The aim of the course is to provide an opportunity for guests to begin to explore for themselves whether Christianity might be relevant and true. We begin with a full meal. We then have a short video (about 10 minutes), which has been set in a local context (a key feature of the course!). We then have a time of discussion afterwards. The three sessions are called "Is it relevant?"; "Is it true?" and "What's in it for me?"

So – if this course appeals to you in any way, do come. If you just want to try the first session before committing to anything more, that's fine as well. Please let me know beforehand, though, so that the caterers can have a reliable set of numbers.
