

Hi folks,

If you love wildlife, then the Polden villages are wonderful places to live. We have some amazing nature reserves within about a quarter of an hour's drive from the front door, where you can see species that are common here but rare elsewhere in the UK: for example, marsh harriers, bitterns and otters.

That's why we're running a photography exhibition, called "Somerset's Glorious Wildlife" in Shapwick Church, from Wednesday May 18th to Sunday May 22nd. It's being organised along similar lines to the one in June 2018, showcasing some of

the best local wildlife photography.

We have over a dozen invited exhibitors, including Carl Bovis, Chris Hooper and Andrew Kirby, as well as local photographers Kim Hemmings (from Shapwick), Colin Whitcombe and Dan Hargreaves (both from Burtle).
