Hi folks,

For local birdwatchers, this is the season for bearded reedlings. They breed on the reserves, but become much more visible in the autumn as their feeding habits change. I took this photo in October during a guided walk on Shapwick Heath.

Many of us in the area recognise the therapeutic benefits of being in



the countryside – getting immersed in the landscape, or absorbed by watching the wildlife. For a few moments we can escape the stresses of our ordinary, everyday lives, and we can forget the political dramas that dominate the news headlines. When we return to normal life, we often feel refreshed, better able to tackle what lies before us.

There are aspects of religious life that offer similar benefits – especially the opportunity to take a step back from everyday life, to reflect and to be refreshed. But faith in Jesus takes us deeper: when we pray to him, we're not doing it just as a contemplative exercise, but as a way to connect with the God who created everything.

It's easy to despair when looking at the political world: chaos in the Government, chaos in Ukraine, looming disaster with climate change combined with political inaction – but despite all this, if we follow Jesus, we follow a God who remains sovereign over everything. That's why praying to God through Jesus takes us deeper than a walk in the countryside can.
