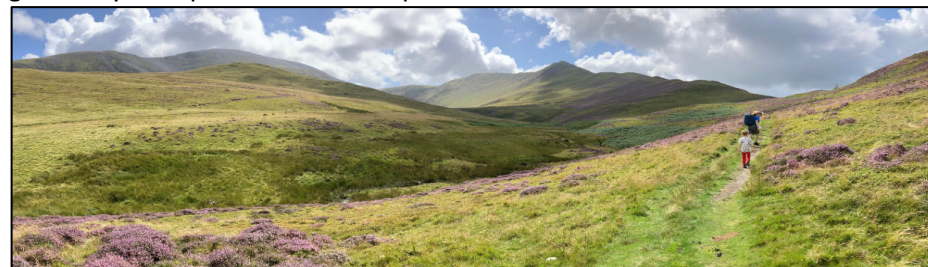
SEPTEMBER 2024
